




### **MEMORY VERSE:**

#### FOR PARENTS

From today's lesson, your child learned that Jesus wants us to trust him (Matt. 14:22-33). Try a simple experiment this week to help your child see how special this act was. Place eight inches of water in a pail or laundry tub. Then have your child try to stand on the water. Talk about how people's feet sink and they cannot walk on top of water, but Jesus was able to do so.

This might be a good time to talk about water safety with your child. Emphasize that boys and girls should never go into water without permission from an adult who is nearby. Point out that even the disciples were not alone in the boat.
