


# THANKS FOR LOVING ME!

cheated the people and took too much money from them.<sup>3</sup>




Luke 5:29-32

Then Levi held a great banquet for Jesus at his

house, and a large crowd of tax collectors and others were eating with them. But the Pharisees and the teachers of the law who belonged to their sect complained to his disciples, "Why do you eat and drink with tax collectors and 'sinners'?"

Who was invited to Levi's dinner? What was the complaint the



Pharisees<sup>4</sup> and teachers made to Jesus? Why do you think they did this?

Jesus answered them, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance."

> <sup>4</sup>Pharisees followed a strict code of behavior, based on their ideas of God's laws. They often considered themselves better than others and would refuse to accept other people "lower" than themselves.

time with tax collectors? How does
Jesus feel about sinners?

Levi was called Matthew,<sup>5</sup> and he became one of Jesus' 12 disciples. He also wrote the Book of Matthew in the Bible.
