
## THE GREAT GIVE AND TAKE

## ONE LIFE FOR MANY

ost of the religious leaders didn't believe Jesus was God's Son. So they arrested Jesus and brought Him before their high court. He was found guilty of blasphemy (making Himself equal with God.) The court didn't have the power to kill Jesus, so they took Him to Pilate, the Roman governor. Pilate tried to free Jesus, but the crowd demanded Jesus be killed. Pilate gave the order, and they led Jesus outside the city and nailed Him to a cross.



Matthew 27:46-48, 50-53

About three in the afternoon Jesus cried out in a loud voice, "Eli, Eli,

lema sabachthani?" (which means "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?").

When some of those standing there heard this, they said, "He's calling Elijah."

¹Pronounced AY-lee AY-lee .luh-MAH sah-BAHK-tah-nee Immediately one of them ran and got a sponge. He filled it with wine vinegar, put it on a staff, and offered it to Jesus to drink.

And when Jesus had cried out again in a loud voice, he gave up his spirit.

Why do you think Jesus would say what He did? What did it mean that Jesus gave up His spirit?

At that moment the curtain of the temple<sup>2</sup> was torn in two from top to bottom. The earth shook, the rocks split and the tombs broke open. The bodies of many holy people who had died were raised to life. They came out of the tombs after

Jesus' resurrection and went into the holy city and appeared to many people.

<sup>2</sup>The curtain separated the holy place of the temple from the most holy room. The holy of holies was entered only once a year by the high priest.





What were some of the things that happened after Jesus died? Why do you think this was important?

Jesus was buried in a sealed tomb.

Three days later, Jesus' followers
found an empty tomb because Jesus

arose from the dead. He appeared to many people. Later one of Jesus' disciples wrote about why Jesus traded His life for our sins.

Read 2 Corinthians 5:15-21. Why did Jesus have to die? What does His victory over death mean for us?





## FLY!

- 4. Fold the remaining flap to meet with the original fold. Again, repeat with the other side.
- 5. Raise the flaps back up.
