

## WATER THAT GIVES LIFE

Jesus came to the town of Sychar<sup>1</sup> in Samaria and rested by Jacob's well.<sup>2</sup> A Samaritan woman

came to the well for water and Jesus asked her for a drink.

Read John 4:9-10. Why was the woman surprised when Jesus spoke to her? What did Jesus say He could give her?

Jesus explained that anyone that drank from Jacob's well would get thirsty again. But whoever drank the water He

gave them would never thirst. Jesus was really talking about the Spirit of God. Then Jesus told the woman to get her husband and return. When the woman told Jesus she had no husband, Jesus agreed. He also told the woman about her previous husbands. The woman then realized Jesus was a prophet of God and asked Him more questions.

The woman said, "I know that Messiah" (called Christ) "is coming. When he comes, he will explain everything to us."



John 4:1-42

Then Jesus declared, "I, the one speaking to you—I am he."

Who did Jesus tell the woman He was? Read John 4:27. When the disciples returned to where Jesus was waiting, what was their response to what they saw?

Then, leaving her water jar, the woman went back to the town and said to the people, "Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Messiah?"

They came out of the town and made their way toward him.

What did the woman do as soon as she found out Jesus was the Messiah?

Many of the Samaritans from that town believed in him because of the woman's testimony, "He told me everything I ever



did." So when the Samaritans came to him, they urged him to stay with them, and he stayed two days. And because of his words many more became believers.

They said to the woman, "We no longer believe just because of what you said; now we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this man really is the Savior of the world."

What happened because the woman shared Jesus with everyone in town?
